

## Big Birding Half Day

On this tour we visit the Jarrah/Marri forest of the Darling Range and foothills to look for many of the southwest Australian endemic bush bird species that can be found in Perth. We also visit an important lake for water birds and other bush birds.

All the sites we visit are easily accessible by car, involve short walks, and some birding from vehicle. This tour is a great option for those who want to maximise the number of species they can add to their lists in a half day. **We usually see between 45 and 65 species depending on luck and birding pace!**

Birds you may see include Western Australian endemic and near-endemic birds like Carnaby's Black-Cockatoo, Red-capped Parrot, Western Rosella, Western Thornbill, Red-winged Fairy-wren, Western Spinebill, Western Wattlebird, Gilbert's Honeyeater, White-breasted Robin, Western Whistler and Red-eared Firetail. Other birds of we will look for include: Tawny Frogmouth, Swamp Harrier, Whistling Kite, Australian Ringneck, Splendid Fairy-wren, and Scarlet Robin. There is a very good chance to see Western Grey Kangaroo on our travels and walks.

**Group Size:** These are private tours for 1 to 4 people. There is no chance the tour will be cancelled as the minimum number will always be reached!

### Pick-up and Drop-off Locations:

Perth, Fremantle, Hills and surrounding suburbs.

### Tour Times:

Pick up at 7 am or 7:30am and return between 4pm and 5:30 pm

### Pricing

Half day tour (approximately 5 hours): 1 person \$220 with additional people \$70 each.
