

## Endemic Bush Birding Day

Your specialist birding guide will show you a diverse selection of key birds in the Jarrah-Marri forests of the Darling Range and the Wandoo woodlands further east. You will be guided on comfortable walks at each location.

Western Australian endemic and near-endemic birds you may see include Carnaby's Black-Cockatoo, Baudin's Black-Cockatoo, Red-capped Parrot, Western Rosella, Western Thornbill, Spotted Scrub-wren, Red-winged Fairy-wren, Western Spinebill, Western Wattlebird, Gilbert's Honeyeater, Rufous Treecreeper, Western-Yellow Robin, White-breasted Robin, Western Whistler and Red-eared Firetail. Other birds of interest include Splendid Fairy-wren, Scarlet Robin and Yellow-plumed Honeyeaters. There is a very good chance to see Western Grey Kangaroo on our travels and walks.

**Group Size:** These are private tours for 1 to 4 people. There is no chance the tour will be cancelled as the minimum number will always be reached!

### Pick-up and Drop-off Locations:

Perth, Fremantle, Hills and surrounding suburbs.

### Tour Times:

Pick up at 7 am or 7:30am and return between 4pm and 5:30 pm
